- iv. Passed SKM level 3 in related field and passed SPM with minimum 1 credit in any subjects with credit in Mathematics and a pass in English; or
- v. Certificate or equivalent in related field; or
- vi. Passed O-Level with at least grade C in three (3) subjects including Mathematics and a pass in English
- vii. Other equivalent qualifications recognised by the Malaysian Government.
