#### Entry Requirements (Master by Mixed-Mode):

- 1. Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.75 as approved by the PPT Senate; OR
- 2. Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 but not reaching 2.75 may be accepted, subject to a thorough internal assessment; OR
- Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 but not reaching 2.50 may be accepted, subject to 5 years of relevant work experience and a thorough internal assessment; OR
- 4. Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a non-related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as approved by the PPT Senate may be accepted, subject to relevant work experience and a thorough internal assessment; OR
- 5. Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a non-related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 but not reaching 2.50 as approved by the PPT

- Senate may be accepted, subject to 5 years of relevant work experience and a thorough internal assessment; OR
- 6. Bachelor's degree (Level 6 MQF) or its equivalent in a non-related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as approved by the PPT Senate and without relevant work experience may be accepted, subject to completing prerequisite courses.
- 7. English Language Competency Requirements for International Students:

  Minimum score of MUET Band 4 or equivalent to CEFR (Mid B2)"
